Under the Program, scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 will be awarded.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

Applicants must be:

- Employed as staff; and/or have been members of the grantor for three of the past five years.
- Have a 3.0 weighted or unweighted GPA or higher in their junior and senior years of high school.
- Have been accepted as a full-time student at an educational institution of higher learning (i.e., trade school, junior college, or four-year college).

Scholarship funds will be paid **directly to the college** and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Foundation at that time an invoice for second-semester tuition and fees, student ID number, and college information.

Application deadline is <u>May 3, 2024</u> by 5:00 p.m. to be received at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Annapolis & Anne Arundel County Wiley H. Bates Club. Late applications are not accepted.
